

At a special meeting of the Malone Village Board, held on August 26, 2010, at 1:15 PM, at the Malone Village Meeting Room, located at 16 Elm Street, the following were present:

Mayor Stewart called the meeting to order at 1:17 PM. We have two committees to hear from today with their recommendations for hiring.

The Highway Committee to report their recommendation on a WWTP Operator Trainee:

The Committee interviewed four applicants and recommends the hiring of Curtis Rottier, at \$12.50 an hour, to start on 9/3/10 for full-time employment (40 hours/week). He has had some heavy equipment training through BOCES. He is willing to get his CDL. He was the best candidate of the four they had. This position was budgeted for and we need a trainee in place for three years before they can take the exam and they must work with a senior operator.

Upon the motion of Trustee Patnode seconded by Trustee LePine and unanimously carried to hire Curtis Rottier, \$12.50 an hour, full-time (40 hours), to start 9/3/10.

The second position is the dispatcher position, which again was in our budget this year.

The Law Enforcement Committee to report their recommendation for full-time Dispatcher:

The Committee gave a short interview to Bruce Burditt and the Chief of Police gave his recommendation to hire Bruce Burditt as a full-time dispatcher. He would start at \$12.75. He was very impressive. We enjoyed speaking with him. He had good control of his speaking. Chief Stone concurred with the committee.

Upon the motion of Trustee Richards seconded by Trustee Patnode and unanimously carried to hire Bruce Burditt as a full-time (40 hour week) civilian dispatcher at the Village Police Department starting at \$12.75/hour, to start 9/3/10.

Upon the motion of Trustee Patnode seconded by Trustee LePine and unanimously carried to adjourn the meeting at 1:25 PM.
